Learning by doing



Eligibility

Eligibility will be based on the IEP team's recommendation/discussion.

Factors that will be considered

- Behavior
- Attendance
- Teacher recommendation
- Age (16 or older)

Note-
Transition students and/or seniors have priority.
Juniors may be considered.

Requirements to get the job

Student must perform basic tasks also asked of the outside work force in order to enter into the work experience program.

Students not in transition would need to meet these requirements.

1. Fill out a general application
2. Complete a basic resume
3. Interview briefly with the transition teacher.

Transition students will meet the above requirements in class.



Time limit for participation

- Students would be limited to no more than 150 hours at minimum wage. (May vary depending on that year's budget)
- Students will be paid once a month on the 20th per school district policy.
- The school district would also be responsible for workman's compensation.
- Students cannot receive credit for the class and be paid for work.
